DRAFT ORDER

Having heard Counsel for the Applicant and the First Respondent:


IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the estate of the First Respondent is placed under a provisional order of sequestration in the hands of the Master of the High Court of South Africa.
2. That a *rule nisi* is hereby issued calling upon all interested parties/persons

concerned to show cause/to give reasons, if any, to this Honourable Court on **THURSDAY, 31 JANUARY 2023 at 10h00** or so soon thereafter as Counsel may be heard as to why:

- 2.1 a final sequestration order should not be granted; and
 - 2.2 the costs of this application should not be costs in the sequestration of the first respondent's estate.
3. That service of the provisional sequestration order is to be effected as follows:
- 3.1 that a copy thereof be served on the First and Second Respondent (or their legal representatives, if any) personally by the Sheriff or his/her deputy (if personal service is not possible after diligent effort, then it is to be served by way of affixing);
 - 3.2 that a copy thereof be served on the Receiver of Revenue; and
 - 3.2 that a copy be served on the First Respondent's employees, if any, and their trade union, if any.
