Having considered the documents filed of record and having heard the legal practitioners of the applicant,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Respondent is provisionally placed under liquidation in the hands of the Master of the High Court of South Africa (Free State Division, Bloemfontein).
2. A Provisional Order is issued calling upon the Respondent and all interested parties to show cause, if any, on the **28th of August 2025 at 09h30** why the Provisional Order of Liquidation of the Respondent should not be made final and that the costs of this application on an attorney and client scale should not be costs in the administration of the insolvent estate of the Respondent.
3. This Order together with a copy of the Notice of Motion and Annexures thereto shall be served upon the Respondent at its registered office and its principal place of business.
4. A copy of this Court Order is furthermore to be served upon:
 - 4.1 Every Registered trade union (if any) that, as far as the Sheriff can reasonably ascertain, represents any of the employees of the Respondent.

- 4.2 The employees of the Respondent by affixing a copy to any notice boards to which the employees may have access to at the registered physical address of the Respondent, or, if there is no access to the premises of the Respondent, by affixing a copy of the Order to the entrance gate of the premises, and, in the event of there not being an entrance gate to the premises, by affixing a copy thereof to the front door of the premises, from which the Respondent conducts any business.
- 4.3 The South African Revenue Services.
- 4.4 The Master of the High Court, Bloemfontein.
5. A copy of this Order is to be published, without delay, in one issue of the *Government Gazette* and in one edition of the newspaper known as the "*Citizen*".
