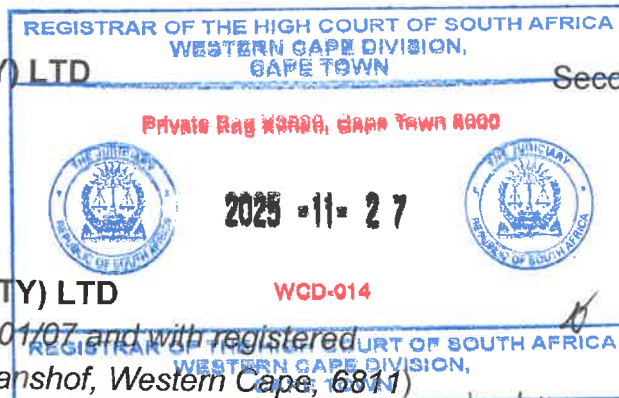

[DRAFT] ORDER

Having read the papers filed of record and having heard counsel for the applicants,
the following order is made:

1. The respondent be and is hereby placed in provisional liquidation in the hands of the Master of the High Court of South Africa (Cape Town).
2. A *rule nisi* is hereby issued calling upon all interested parties to appear and show cause, if any, on **19 January 2026 at 10:00**, why an order in the following terms should not be granted:

- 2.1. Confirming the *rule nisi* and granting an order for the final winding up of the respondent;
- 2.2. that the costs of this application be costs in the winding-up of the respondent on an attorney and client scale; and
- 2.3. ~~further and/or alternative relief~~ *A 2025/11/19*

3. Service of this order shall be effected as follows:

3.1. by the sheriff of this Honourable Court on:

- 3.1.1. the respondent at its registered address and principal place of business;
- 3.1.2. the employees (*if any*) of the respondent at its principal place of business in the manner prescribed by section 346A(1)(b) of the Companies Act, 1973;
- 3.1.3. any trade union representing the respondent's employees (*if any*);
- 3.1.4. the South African Revenue Services, Cape Town; and
- 3.1.5. The Master of the High Court, Cape Town.



- 3.2. by publication in each of the *Cape Times* and *Die Burger* newspapers;
- 3.3. by registered mail on the respondent's creditors who have claims (*if any and if known*);
- 4. Registrar shall transmit a copy of this order to the Sheriff of the province in which the office of the company (respondent) is situated (Western Cape) and to the Sheriff of every province in which it appears that the company (respondent) owns business.
- 5. The Sheriff shall attach all property which appears to belong to the company (respondent) and transmit to the Master an inventory of all property attached by him/her in terms of Section 19 of the Insolvency Act, 24 of 1936.
- 6. The costs of this application shall be costs in the liquidation.
