FILED OF RECORD IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That the respondent be placed in provisional liquidation in the hands of the Master of the above honourable Court;
2. That a *Rule Nisi* be issued calling upon all interested parties to give reasons, if any, on **FRIDAY, 22 MAY 2026** as to why an order in the following terms should not be granted:
 - 2.1 That the respondent be placed under final liquidation;
 - 2.2 That the cost of this application be costs in the liquidation of the respondent.
3. That service and publication of the provisional liquidation order and *Rule Nisi* granted in terms of paragraphs 1 and 2 above shall be effected as follows:

- 3.1 That a true copy thereof shall be served on the respondent at its registered address by the Sheriff or his deputy;
 - 3.2 that a true copy thereof shall be served on the South African Revenue Services;
 - 3.3 that a true copy thereof shall be served on the respondent's employees and any registered trade union(s) that may represent said employees by the Sheriff or his deputy;
 - 3.4 that a true copy thereof shall be published in one edition each of the "THE CAPE TIMES" and "DIE BURGER" newspapers.
4. That, if at the time of the final winding up of the respondent, the respondent is in final deregistration, that the respondent's dissolution be declared void by the above Honourable Court in terms of Item 9 of Schedule 5 of the Companies Act No. 71 of 2008 read with section 420 of the Companies Act No. 61 of 1973.
 5. That the Registrar shall transmit a copy of this order to the Sheriff of the province in which the respondent's registered office is situate and to the Sheriff of every province in which it appears that the respondent owns business. The Sheriff shall attach all property which appears to belong to the respondent and transmit an inventory of all property so attached by him to the Master in terms of section 19 of the insolvency Act No. 24 of 1936.

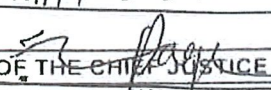
